

Amateur Television for Silicon Valley

K6BEN is a amateur television station repeater located on Loma Prieta to provide coverage of south San Francisco bay area and Monterey Bay area in California. Input is 1255 MHz FM, output is 427.25 MHz AM. Use a cable ready TV set on channel 58. For best results, point a UHF yagi (vertically polarized) toward Loma Prieta. J-pole and rabbit ears antennas can work well with line-of-sight. Audio uplink is 145.510 MHz simplex.
